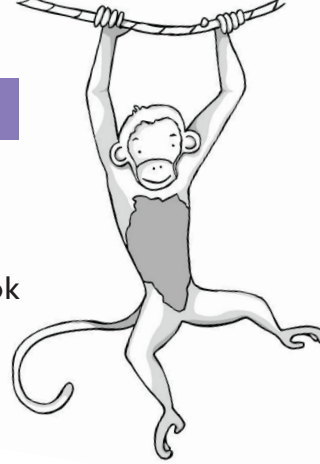


Go to the Animal Emporium in Sailortown.

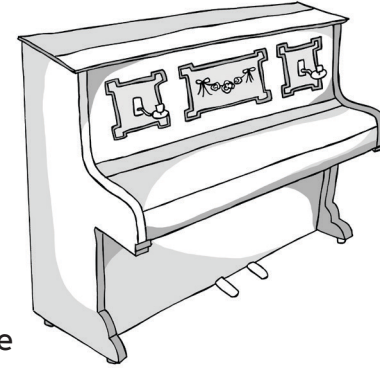
